1 Thessalonians 2:7 But we proved to be gentle among you, as a nursing mother tenderly cares for her own children. 8 Having so fond an affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us. 9 For you recall, brethren, our labor and hardship, how working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God.

PERSONAL CARE (v. 7-8)

- 1 Thessalonians 2:7 But we proved to be gentle among you, as a nursing mother tenderly cares for her own children. 8 Having so fond an affection for you, we were well-pleased to impart to you not only the gospel of God but also our own lives, because you had become very dear to us.
- -Gently showed affection instead of just authority.
- -Gladly shared the gospel. (v.8)
- -Freely shared their lives. (v.8)

PERSONAL CHARACTER (v. 9-10)

1 Thessalonians 2:9 For you recall, brethren, our labor and hardship, how working night and day so as not to be a burden to any of you, we proclaimed to you the gospel of God. 10 You are witnesses, and so is God, how devoutly and uprightly and blamelessly we behaved toward you believers;

- -"Skin in the game" (9a)
- The Savior at the center (9b)
- Credible conduct (v.10)







Thrive at spiritual parenthood through...

PERSONAL COACHING (v. 11-12)



- 1 Thessalonians 2:11 just as you know how we were exhorting and encouraging and imploring each one of you as a father would his own children, 12 so that you would walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.
- -Exhorting: parakaleo- to come alongside and invite strongly



- -Encouraging: paramutheomai-to come alongside and cheer up
- -Imploring: marturomai-to urge something as a matter of great importance, testify, insist on by firsthand experience!
