Four habits of the heart that will lead to SUSTAINABLE ZEAL as we serve Christ...

I. URGENT PRAYER (vs. 7)

I. URGENT PRAYER (vs. 7)

1Pet. 4:7 The end of all things is near; therefore, be of sound judgment and sober *spirit* for the purpose of prayer.

End=telos: the goal or culmination

"2Pet. 3:8 But do not let this one *fact* escape your notice, beloved, that with the Lord one day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years like one day. 9 The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.

II. FERVENT LOVE (vs. 8,9)

- 1 Peter 4:8 Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.
 9 Be hospitable to one another without complaint.
- Fervent love is a stretching love.
 Fervent=EKTENE: extended or stretched out like an athlete straining every muscle toward a goal
- Fervent love is a forgiving love.
 - Prov. 10:12 Hatred stirs up dissension, but love covers over all wrongs.

II. FERVENT LOVE (vs. 8,9)

- 1 Peter 4:8 Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.
 9 Be hospitable to one another without complaint.
- Fervent love is hospitable without complaint.
 "True Christian hospitality is making people feel at home, when you wish they were at home."-Donald Coggan

- 1 Peter 4:10 As each one has received a *special* gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
- Accept that you have a supernatural gift in Christ.
- · Activate your spiritual gift to benefit others.
- · Manage your spiritual gift with gratitude.

IV. EMPOWERING NEED (vs. 11)

- 1 Peter 4:11 Whoever speaks, is to do so as one who is speaking the utterances of God; whoever serves is to do so as one who is serving by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.
