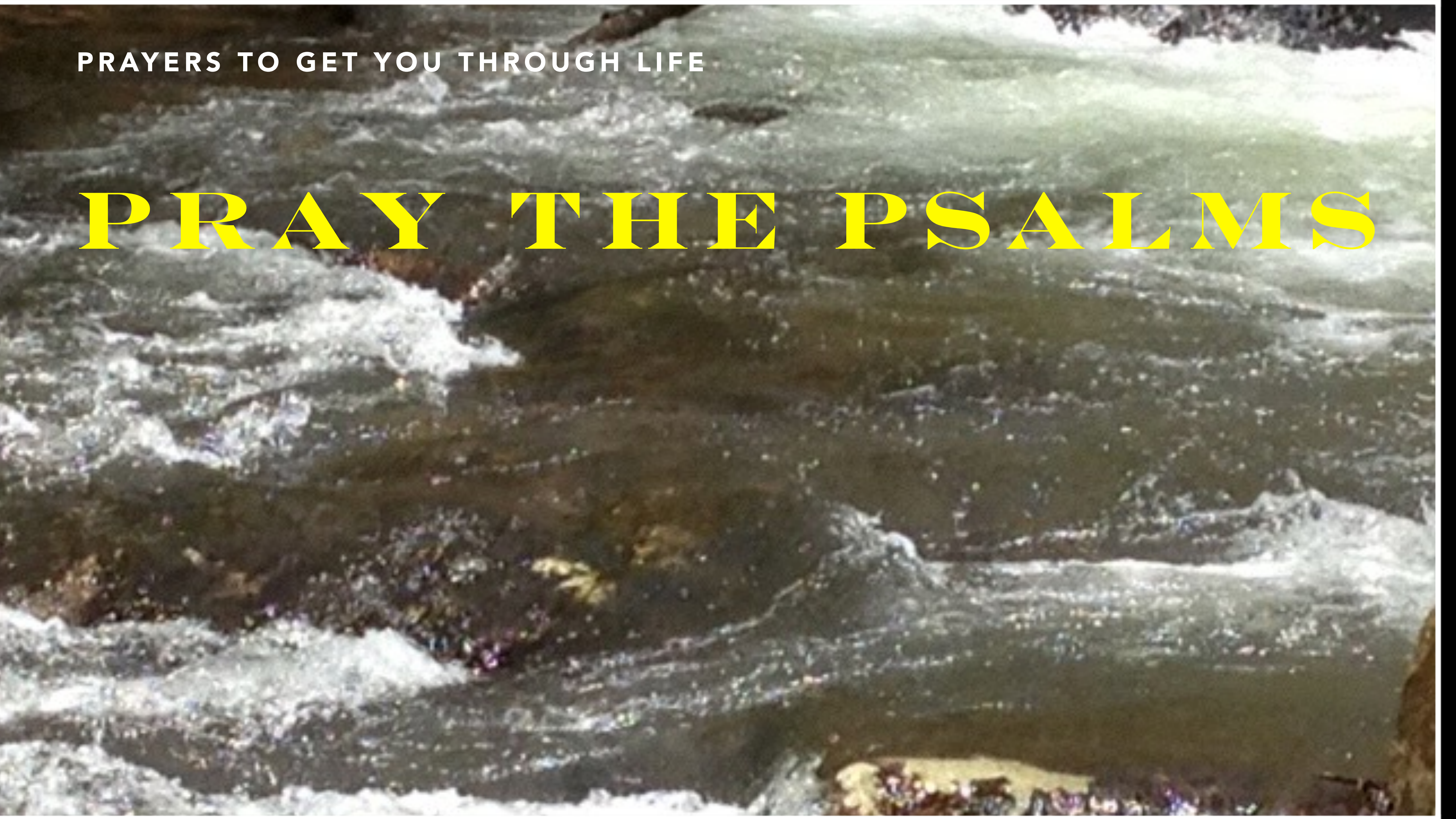

- 29 – shir – song
- 13 – maskil – contemplative poem
- 06 – miktam – inscription poem
- 05 – tepillah – prayer
- 01 – tehillah – praise (Ps. 145)

WHO WROTE THE PSALMS

- Moses (Ps 90)
- Solomon (Pss 72, 127)
- Asaph (Pss 50, 73-83)
- Heman & Ethan (Pss 88, 89)
- David (at least 73 are attributed to him)
- Exilic and Post-Exilic period (Pss 74, 79, 137, 126, 147)
