

It's about your Father being GOOD!

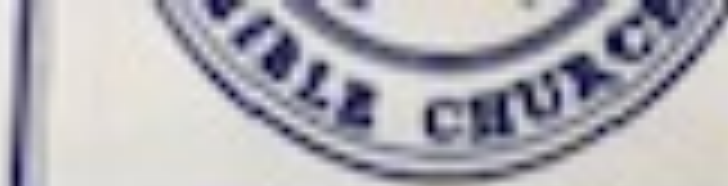
