 - 21 My mouth will speak the praise of the LORD, and all flesh will bless His holy name forever and ever.
 - 3 Great is the LORD, and highly to be praised, And His greatnesss is unsearchable.


Psalm 145:4 One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts.



I. THE EXPECTATION: EAGERLY PRAISE GOD EVERY DAY (vs. 1-7, 21)

David expected praise to God from others. (vs. 4-7)

Psalm 145:6 Men shall speak of the power of Your awesome acts, and I will tell of Your greatness.

Daniel 4:2 I am delighted to tell you about the signs and wonders the most high God has done for me.

Psalm 145: 7 They shall eagerly utter the memory of Your abundant goodness and will shout joyfully of Your righteousness.

Praise God for His great <u>kindness.</u> (vs. 8-9)

Psa. 145:8 The LORD is gracious and merciful; Slow to anger and great in lovingkindness.

9 The LORD is good to all, And His mercies are over all His works.

2 Peter 3:9

10 All Your works shall give thanks to You, O LORD, And Your godly ones shall bless You.

11 They shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom And talk of Your power;

12 To make known to the sons of men Your mighty acts
And the glory of the majesty of Your kingdom.

13 Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And Your dominion *endures* throughout all generations.

Psa. 145:14 The LORD sustains all who fall And raises up all who are bowed down.

15 The eyes of all look to You,
And You give them their food in due time.

16 You open Your hand
And satisfy the desire of every living thing.

17 The LORD is righteous in all His ways
And kind in all His deeds.

Psalm 145:18 The LORD is **near** to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth.

19 He will **fulfill the desire** of those who fear Him; He will also **hear** their cry and will **save** them.

20 The LORD **keeps** all who love Him, But all the wicked He will destroy.
