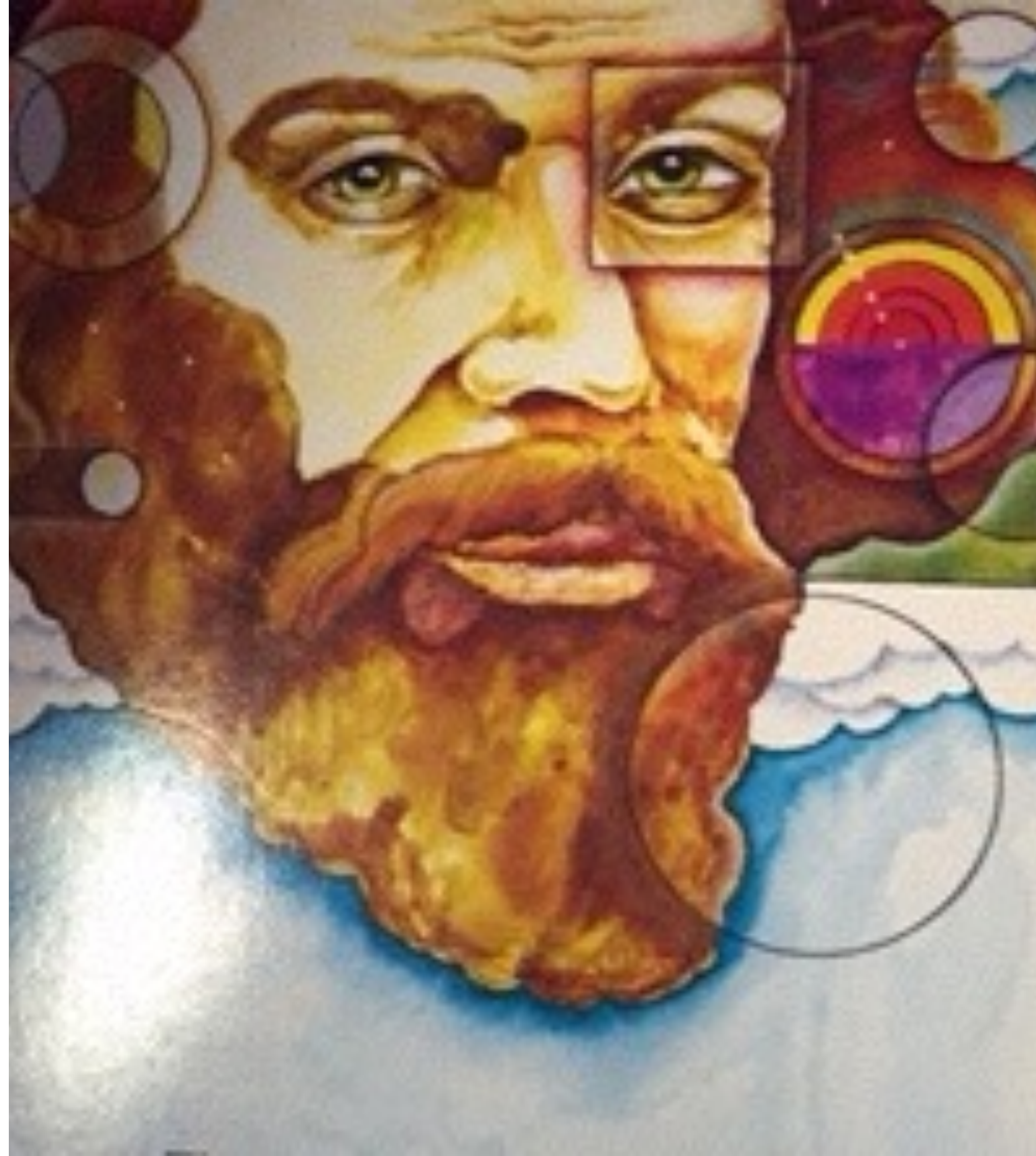

**Alexander the Great
4 Generals:
Cassander - Greece
Lysimachus - Asia Minor
Seleucus - Syria & Babylon
Ptolemy - Egypt & Israel**

**Daniel
11:5**

**Ptolemy I
Seleucus I**

Daniel 11:6

**Ptolemy II sent
Berenice to marry
Antiochus II
to form an alliance.**

**Antiochus II first wife was Laodiceia.
She conspired to have Antiochus II & Berenice killed.
Ptolemy II died at the same time.**

**Daniel
11:7-8**

**Berenice's brother, Ptolemy III
defeated Seleucus II
and returned to Egypt with the spoil in 242BC
The next 18 years had peace between the nations**

**Daniel
11:9**

**Seleucus III failed to take back
his kingdom from Ptolemy III**

**Daniel
11:10**

**Antiochus III recaptured
territory in Phoenicia from
Ptolemy IV**

**Daniel
11:11-12**

**Ptolemy IV defeated Antiochus's forces at
the battle of Raphia in 217BC**

**Daniel
11:13-14**

**Antiochus launched a second invasion
of coastal region of Syria after
Ptolemy IV died
and crushes Egypt
(aided by pro-Seleucid Jews)**

**Daniel
11:15-16**

**Antiochus's forces defeated Ptolemy V
at the battle of Paneas.
Shortly after this, he began to control the
Promised Land**

**Daniel
11:17**

**Antiochus III sent Cleopatra I
to marry Ptolemy V
but it backfired**

**Daniel
11:18-19**

**Antiochus III attacks Greece but Rome intervened.
Couple of years later he is killed while robbing a temple
in his own land**

**Daniel
11:20**

**Seleucus IV succeeded Antiochus III.
Assassinated by his financial minister**

**Daniel
11:21**

Antiochus IV arrives on the scene (175-164BC)

**Daniel
11:22-24**

**Antiochus IV defeated forces of Ptolemy VI in
his own land.**

**Deposed Jewish High Priest, Onias.
Consolidates power by intrigue**

**Daniel
11:25-28**

**Antiochus IV has the ultimate goal
of conquering Egypt. Conquers coastland and
captures Ptolemy VI in 169BC
On return, he loots Temple**

**Daniel
11:29-31**

**Antiochus IV makes another attack on Egypt
but is repelled by Rome
On way back through Jerusalem he performs
the abomination of desolation**

**Daniel
11:32-35**

**Antiochus IV unleashes extreme
persecution upon the Jewish nation
and serve as the precursor to
the AntiChrist**
