




# SO WHAT IS A BREAKTHROUGH

wants me to be*


*...to receive from God all He wants to

*2Sam 5:18-20 Now the Philistines came and spread themselves out in the valley of Rephaim. Then David inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I go up against the Philistines? Will You give them into my hand?" And the LORD said to David, "Go up, for I will certainly give the Philistines into your hand." So David came to Baal-perazim and defeated them there; and he said, "The LORD has broken through my enemies before me like the breakthrough of waters." Therefore he named that place Baal-perazim.*




# PASSIONATELY SEEK GOD'S PLAN
